<u>Mid Cap Core Composite</u> includes all portfolios that invest in mid cap equities with the goal of providing long-term capital growth. The benchmark for the Mid Cap Core Composite is the S&P400. The benchmark includes 400 US mid-sized companies. Market caps of eligible companies in the benchmark range from \$1.0 billion to \$17.2 billion. The minimum account size for this composite is \$250 thousand. The Mid Cap inception date is 4/1/2004. The Mid Cap Core Composite was created January 1, 2007.

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Portfolio returns are calculated after the deduction of actual trading expenses incurred during the period. Estimated trading expenses are not used. Returns include returns from cash, cash equivalents, and accrued income from fixed income securities. Dividends are accounted for on a cash basis and are gross of non-reclaimable withholding taxes

(withholding taxes are immaterial to the performance calculation) Past performance is not indicative of future results.

The U.S. Dollar is the currency used to express performance. Returns are presented gross and net of management fees and include the reinvestment of all income. Net of fee performance was calculated using the highest management fees of 1.25%, applied monthly. The annual composite dispersion presented is an asset-weighted standard deviation calculated for the accounts in the composite the entire year using gross returns. Policies for valuing investments, calculating performance, and preparing GIPS reports are available upon request.

The investment management fee schedule for the composite is 1.25% on the first \$1 million, 1.00% on the next \$4 million, and 0.75% on the remainder. Actual investment advisory fees incurred by clients may vary.
